**PARTS LIST:**

Mini-print wrapping paper  
Stick-to-itself ribbon  
Wooden blocks

## Assembly Instructions

The templates provided are perfectly sized to cut wrapping paper for these blocks. They may vary slightly in size but the basic measurements are provided here so you can make your own if you need more.

Block A:  $1\frac{11}{16}$ " x  $1\frac{3}{16}$ " x  $\frac{5}{16}$ "

Block B:  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x  $1\frac{3}{16}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ "

Block C:  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $\frac{5}{16}$ "

Block D:  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $\frac{3}{8}$ "

Use this sheet or copy the templates on ordinary printer paper. Use a glue stick to adhere them to thin cardboard, such as from a cereal box.

When the glue has set, cut out the templates; use them to draw the size you need on the wrapping paper and cut out. (If you are cutting several sheets at once, label the papers A, B, etc. so you know which block it will fit.)

1. To wrap, apply glue stick to the long side of a block, a little more than halfway across.
2. Adhere the short edge of a paper, centered side-to-side.
3. Wrap the paper around the block and glue the other edge.
4. Crease the ends where they will fold, and tuck in two short sides. Work flat on a table to make neat folds.
5. Create the bottom flap, then flip the block over for the top folds.
6. Repeat on the other end of the block, then apply glue to the top flaps and stick in place.
